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• Soybean Scouting School •

When students attended the soybean scouting school hosted at the UT AgResearch Center at Jackson, students heard from multiple people who spoke about what to look for when scouting soybeans, different diseases and pests at different life cycles of the soybean plant, and even different treatments used when finding specific pests. The UT agriculture professionals that hosted the event had examples of different pests for students to see and handle and gave prime examples of how to differentiate those pests. Also, students had the opportunity to scout research plots of soybeans at different stages of growth to determine various pests.
